

# VILLAGE OF RUIDOSO

## ORDINANCE 2007-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF RUIDOSO MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY APPENDIX A FEE SCHEDULE TO INCORPORATE WASTEWATER RATE FEES.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF RUIDOSO THAT Appendix A Fee Schedule, is hereby amended by the addition of new text and modification of existing text as follows:

### APPENDIX A FEE SCHEDULE

#### Wastewater treatment rates:

(1) The minimum monthly rate shall be adjusted annually, at the beginning of the fiscal year, using the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as calculated and published by the state. The fees shown are for Fiscal Year 2007-2008.

(2) Minimum monthly charge per service unit:

<u>Water Meter Size (inches)</u>	<u>Residential</u>	<u>Commercial</u>	<u>Institutional or Industrial</u>
<u>3/4</u>	<u>32.58</u>	<u>47.36</u>	<u>62.14</u>

(3) Commodity charge. In addition, after the minimum monthly charge, customers shall be charged 1.80 per 1,000 gallons of water used in excess of 4,000 gallons, as determined by the meter reading for water.
